The most frequently asked question we get from our alumni is this: Can I still use the Law Library after I graduate?

The answer is: YES!

Consider the reference librarians and the Library staff your friends for life.

Although you will lose free access to Westlaw and Lexis shortly after graduation, you can continue to come into the Library to access a wide variety of electronic databases at our six public-access computers, including

1. Lexis Public Access, including Shepard's
2. HeinOnline
3. BNA databases in a wide variety of practice areas
4. ELR (Environmental Law Reporter)

Things you can do after graduation:

1. Get help from the reference librarians, either in person, via our email reference service <http://libraryanswers.law.pace.edu>, or phone 914-422-4208.
2. Use the wireless network. Contact Law ITS at 914-422-4290 or lawits@law.pace.edu to request a wireless account .

Things you won't be able to do (and alternatives):

1. Use the computer lab—but there are six public-access computers near the reference desk with access to many databases, the Internet, and Microsoft Office.
2. Have a printer account—but you can pay as you go for printing at the same cost (6¢ a page).
3. Use Westlaw—but we have a public-access version of Lexis.
4. Take out books that circulate—but you can join the Friends of Pace Law Library for an annual fee of \$100.

Friends of Pace Law Library

Alumni who join Friends of Pace Library are entitled to take out circulating books and to reduced cost document delivery services.

Pace Law graduates have free membership in Friends until the end of your graduation year. After that, Pace Law alumni pay an annual membership fee of \$100.
