Pace Environmental Notes is published each month during the school year, September through May. Back issues may be found by following the P.E.N. link on the Law Library's "Internet Resources" web page.

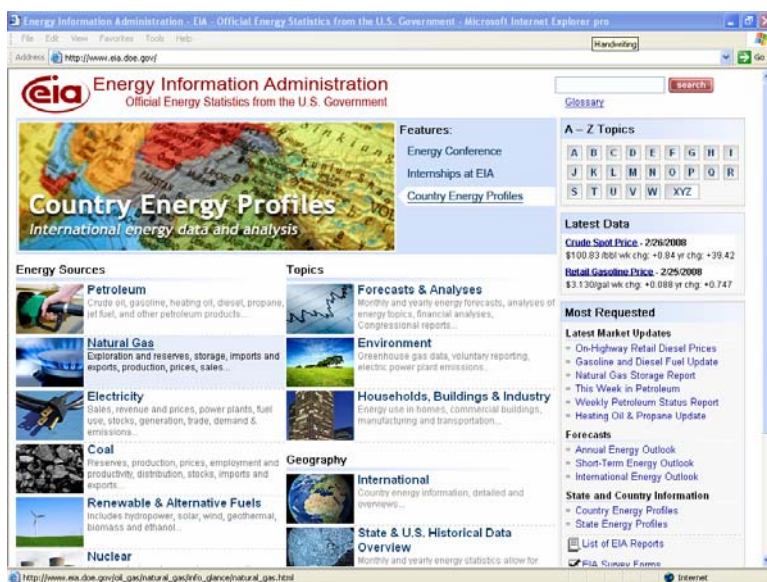

Online Resources

U.S. ENERGY INFORMATION ADMINISTRATION.

At the Energy Information Administration (EIA) web site you will find statistics on, and analysis of, the full range of energy options from traditional gas and oil to renewables. The information available covers both U.S. energy sources as well as international and foreign data.

Navigating the overwhelming amount of information on the site is relatively easy though it may take a bit clicking to find some of the more obscure information. A search box on the upper right hand side of the screen provides direct access to the sites database but most simple searches result in a large number of returns. Just below the search box they provide an A-Z guide to topics. Clicking on a letter provides you

will a list of documents arranged by topic. Clicking on “N” gives you a list of items beginning with “Namibia Country Analysis Profile” all the way to “NYMEX Futures Price.”

As you might note from the previous sentence, the site include current price information on energy resources including the daily price of crude oil and gasoline. Country profiles include the nation’s current energy usage and carbon dioxide emissions as well as historical data and trends.

A broad but direct link to some data is uses the “Energy Topics” links on the center of the front page. The Energy links include: Petroleum, Natural Gas, Electricity, Coal, Renewable and Alternative Fuels, and Nuclear. Topics include: Forecasts and Analysis, Environment, and Households, Buildings, and Industry. Geographic links include: International, and State and US Historical Data. For example, when you click on “Environment” you obtain data on historical and current greenhouse gas production by type of gas, type of industry, and energy source. Anyone interested in accurate statistical information on any aspect of energy usage and production will more than likely find what they need at this site.
