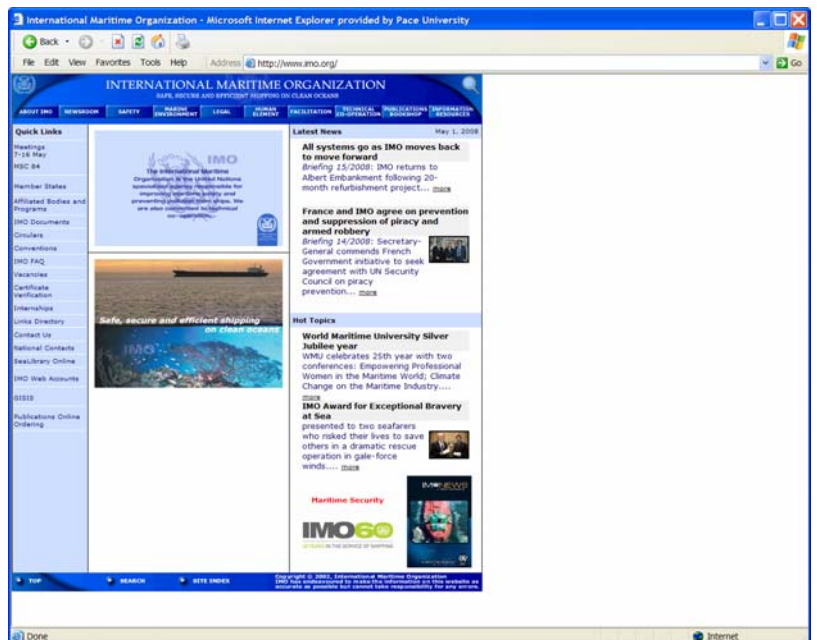
Pace Environmental Notes is published each month during the school year, September through May. Back issues may be found by following the P.E.N. link on the Law Library's "Internet Resources" web page.

Online Resources

INTERNATIONAL MARITIME ORGANIZATION (IMO).

The IMO is the United Nations agency charged with developing and maintaining a comprehensive regulatory framework governing the use of the seas for shipping. As such its jurisdiction covers marine transport, labor concerns for merchant seaman, as well as, environmental issues resulting from maritime shipping. The IMO has over 167 member states. Among the IMO's charges is the administration of a number of environmental conventions including, International Convention for the Prevention of Marine Pollution from Ships(MARPOL), the International Convention on Oil Pollution Preparedness, Response and Co-operation, the International Convention on Civil Liability for Oil Pollution Damage, and the

convention establishing the International Fund for Compensation for Oil Pollution Damage. The IMO website is somewhat complicated and contains an overwhelming amount of information much of which is not related to the marine environment. However, clicking on the “Marine Environment” link on the main navigation bar brings you to a page devoted to the agencies environmental work. On that page, you will find links to the text of the various environmental conventions administered by the agency. On the right hand side of this page you will find a list of links to issue related pages ranging from “Prevention of Pollution,” to “Ballast Water Management,” to “Places of Refuge,” to “Particularly Sensitive Sea Areas (PSSA).” Each link brings you to information dealing with that activity. For example, the PSSA link brings you to a page with information defining the sensitive sea areas that include the Great Barrier Reef, the Galapagos Archipelago, and the Florida Keys. If you are doing any work on the ocean environment the IMP site is worth exploring in detail.
