Marsha Steinhardt concluded her remarkable judicial career in December, 2020, the last nine years of which were spent as the Judge in Charge of the Medical Malpractice Trial Readiness Part, Kings County, where she presided over countless successful settlement conferences.

She served for four years in the Civil Court of the City of New York and was thereafter elected to the Supreme Court in 1994. Her tenure on the bench was spent, for the most part, in the court room, trying cases of varying complexities.
