Seth McKee is Land Conservation Director for Scenic Hudson, Inc., based in Poughkeepsie, New York. Seth has led Scenic Hudson's Land Acquisition Team since 2007, and has worked for the organization's land conservation program since 1991. Seth has conserved thousands of acres of land for public enjoyment and natural resource protection, and has overseen the conservation of many more. He spearheaded the organization's farmland protection initiative and in 2007 led the development of a new set of conservation priorities for Scenic Hudson. Seth has a Masters degree in Regional Planning from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. Before joining Scenic Hudson, he worked in land stewardship for The Nature Conservancy's North Carolina chapter, and in the 1980's developed programs in Asia and the Pacific region for the U.S. Peace Corps. Seth is a member of the Advisory Board of the Land Trust Alliance's New York Program. In his spare time, Seth is a member and former co-chair of the Town of New Paltz Clean Water and Open Space Protection Commission, and Chairman of the Conservation Committee of the New York-New Jersey Trail Conference.
