All Visiting Scholars are supervised by a Pace Law School faculty member, who will offer you support, feedback, and overall guidance in your research. What is included:

- You shall receive the following:
 - Pace ID card
 - Username and password for free WIFI access
 - Pace Law School email address
- Access to the Pace Law Library stacks and open study spaces
- Access to library computer labs
- Ability to attend all lectures as well as on-campus events
- Ability to audit classes with the permission of your advisor and the professor teaching the course
- Email access to your advisor
- Access to online resources including Lexis, Bloomberg Law, and Westlaw provided that the Law School's agreements with those vendors permit Visiting Scholars to access those resources
 - Free Lexis printing when using the dedicated Lexis printers in the computer lab



What is NOT included:

- Access to the Pace One Card System
- Office space or use of a dedicated computer
- Borrowing privileges, interlibrary loans, and document delivery
- Printing and photocopying
- Use of library study rooms
- Externships
